## Please note:

- Teachers are expected to be live and offering CHUNKED instruction while students are expected to be working during the live session (not just listening/watching).
- To balance the amount of screen time during the day, teachers may allow students to logoff during the work period, but the teacher should be live and available in the event a student has questions and needs to log back on to the session during the first 35 minutes of class.
- We encourage lessons and activities that allow students to be away from their computer screen for their learning when possible, but understand each content/class has unique needs.
- If a teacher feels homework is necessary, we encourage that it be completed during the school day to minimize screen time outside of school hours. Homework and projects are permissible if screen time is not required.
