#### 2021 Book Scholarship Guidelines and Application

The North Dallas Suburban Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc., is a public service organization that provides service and assistance to the African-American community in the North Dallas suburbs. The Scholarship Committee of the North Dallas Suburban Alumnae Chapter requests your assistance in identifying students who qualify for our annual scholarship awards. We are seeking candidates who meet the following requirements:

- ∆ Must be an African-American male or female student
- Must be a graduating high school senior Δ
- Must attend school and reside in one of the following cities: Addison, Carrollton, Coppell, Dallas, Farmers Branch, Garland, Irving, Mesquite, Plano, or Richardson
- Δ Must possess a grade point average of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) or a 4.0 or higher (on a 5.0 scale)
- Δ Must exhibit leadership abilities and engage in community service
- Δ Must have plans to attend an accredited college or university within one year of high school graduation

Note: If applicant participates in any North Dallas Suburban Alumnae's youth programs, they are able to apply even if not living in the chapter's service area.

Attached is an application form that may be forwarded as you deem appropriate. Please note that in addition to the eligibility criteria above, applicants are required to submit:

- $\Delta$  A non-returnable professional headshot photo (no larger than 5x7) emailed to scholarship@dstndsa.org using the subject line: NDSA Scholarship-Student's First Name and Last Name
- $^\Delta$  A completed, typed application form including a one-page essay  $^\Delta$  Two typed letters of recommendation from non-family members, one of which must be from a high school counselor on official school/district letterhead. The counselor letter should provide clarification regarding the district's GPA scale or application will be VOID.

- Both letters should include the following:
  1. The name, address, and contact information for the reference
  - 2. The relationship to the applicant and length of time the reference has known the applicant
  - 3. A description of the applicant's attributes and characteristics
  - 4. An explanation of how the applicant has the perseverance to succeed at the college/university level
