What can I donate?

Shoes: New and gently used (but in great condition, clean, non-stinky) shoes and boots in child and small-adult sizes in a bag marked with the size of the shoes. Mason-Rice parent Martha Bixby has worked closely with the Brockton Workers Alliance, who are supporting a large number of families who recently immigrated from Haiti and Central America to Brockton, and their kids need shoes!

Home Goods: Like-new bedding (sheets and blankets) and towels (dish towels, hand towels, wash cloths, bath towels, bath mats). Mason-Rice Green Team is partnering with Welcome Home, a local non-profit in Newton Centre, that collects and redistributes like-new household items to dozens of people in need each month. Donations are tax-deductible.

When and where to drop off items:

Between now and 10/18, you may drop off items in a bag marked with a brief description of the items and sizes to 51 Hyde Street, Newton Highlands or 31 Crescent Avenue, Newton Centre.

We will also be doing a collection at Mason-Rice on the following dates/times:

- **Thursday, 10/7** 4-7pm, during the "First Thursdays" Fall Food Truck event (there will be a labeled collection box at Mason-Rice parking lot)
- Monday, 10/18 2:50-3pm (there will be a sign near the picnic table at Mason-Rice playground)
