

IMPORTANT ART GUIDELINES

Using our recommended art materials will result in more vibrant keepsake products. Follow these Art Guidelines and your students will create art their parents will treasure.



- Use the art paper provided in Starter Kit rather than construction paper or scratch art
- Avoid using photography, magazine cutouts, and copyrighted images
- Use bright, bold colors to create vibrant, themed artwork that fills the entire page
- Work with mediums like markers, water colors, crayons, tempera paint, acrylic paint, and paint sticks
- Avoid using sketching pencils, flourescent colors, highlighters, glitter, sand, salt, buttons, feathers, and googly eyes





- Incorporate students' name and year on the front of the art—parents love it!
- Make sure that it is at least 1" away from the edge of the paper
- Place each student's label on the back of their artwork in the upper left corner to indicate orientation
- Use light pencil if you need to write on the back of the art
- Artwork can be vertical or horizontal
