## **Rules:**

- 1. Use an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of plain, white paper (e.g. copier/printer paper)
- 2. Make sure the paper is vertical (portrait).
- 3. Use the entire page or half page for your design.
- 4. Fill out this sheet with your name, teacher, and grade so we know the submission is yours.
- 5. Attach this sheet on top of your entry, using a paper clip, and return it to your teacher or the office.
- 6. Submissions must be received by:

Monday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 2:45 pm

## **Instructions:**

- Use markers, crayons, colored pencils, paint, etc.
  - You may not glue or attach anything to the page that sticks up because entries must be scanned.
- Try to incorporate the theme into your design.
  - You don't necessarily have to put the theme words in your design but you should try to incorporate the concept
- Please make sure that you *paper clip* this form with your name, grade, and teacher's name on top of your entry.
- DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE ACTUAL DESIGN, just on the entry form that you attach to it.

# **Design Tips:**

- Make sure your lettering is very neat.
- Make sure everything is spelled correctly.
- Bright and vivid colors make better artwork because they scan better.
- Don't put lettering or important design elements at the very edges of the page (1/4 inch all the way around) as they will get cut off. Your background and other parts of your picture should go all the way to the edges, though.
- Be creative and use your imagination!

### Other information:

- Beverly students and staff in any grade level may submit artwork.
- We will try to put as many entries as we can into the yearbook. However, due to space constraints, it is not guaranteed that all entries will be included.
- Entries will be scanned, so no changes may be made after the entries are submitted.
